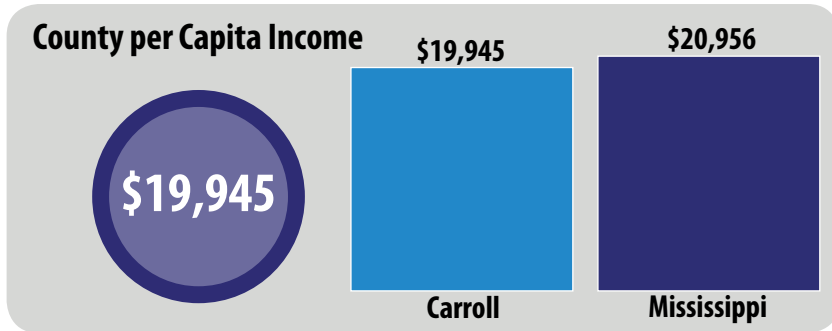

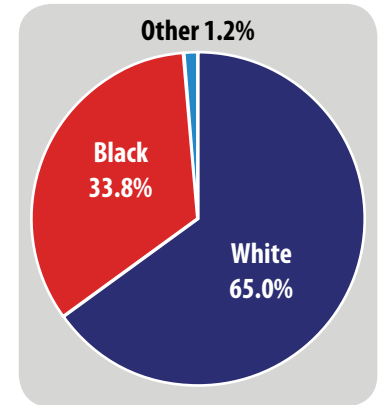

Percent of Kids Living in Single-Parent Households

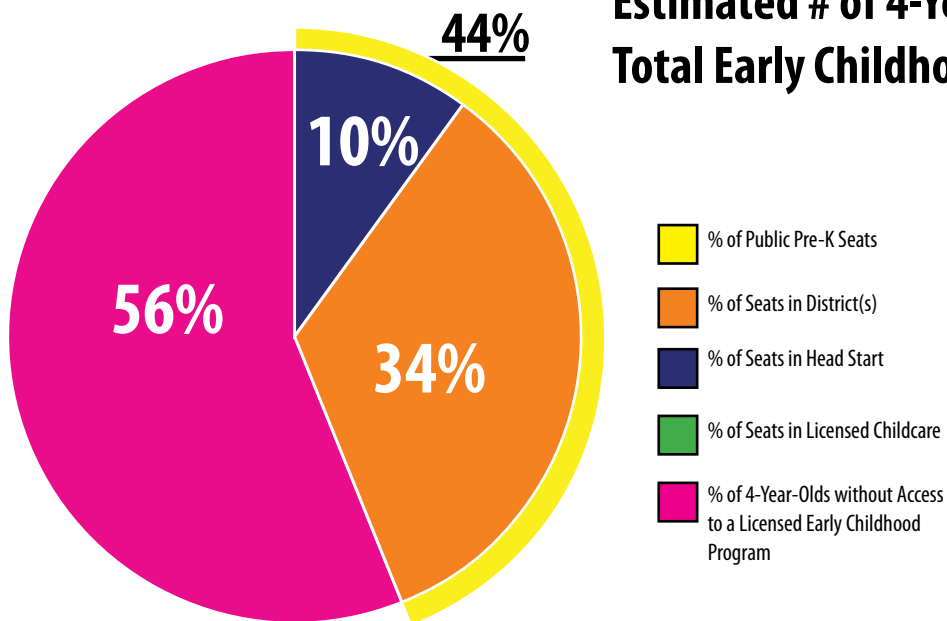


Racial Breakdown of the County
