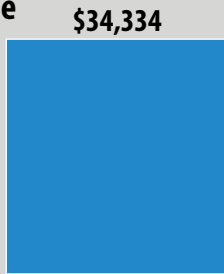


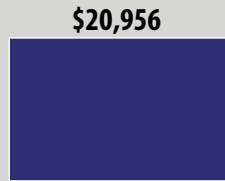

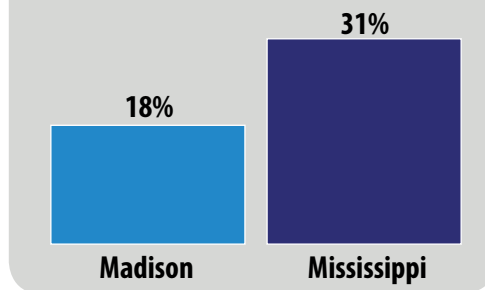

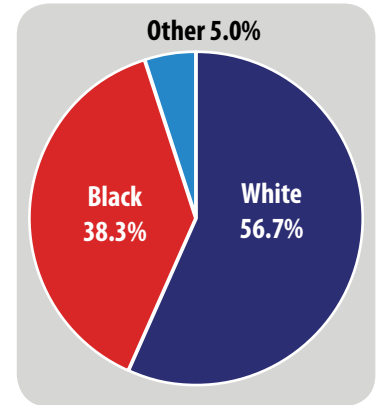
## Percent of Kids Living in Single-Parent Households



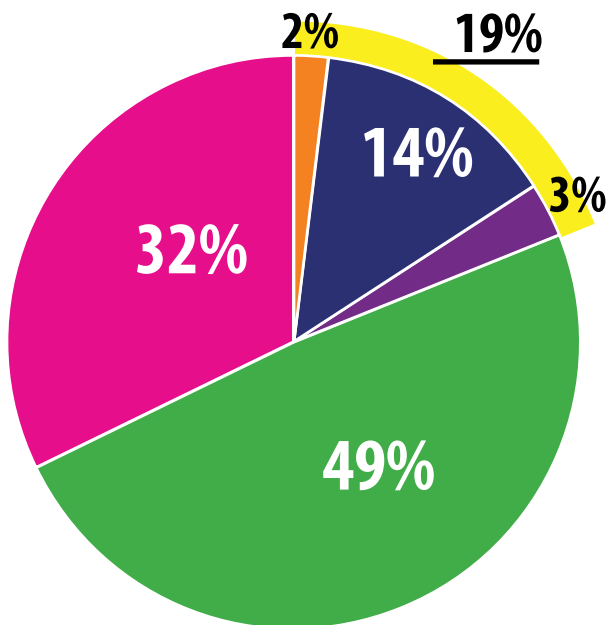
## % of Kids Living in Poverty
