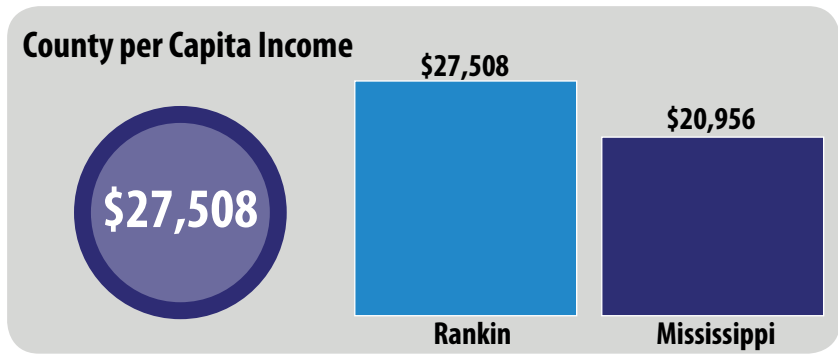

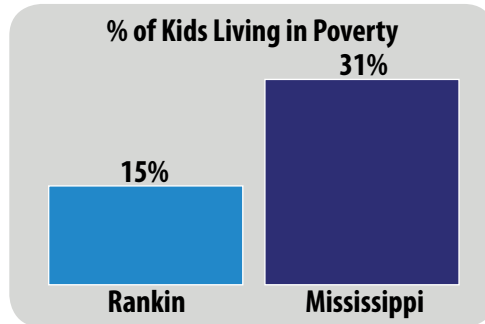

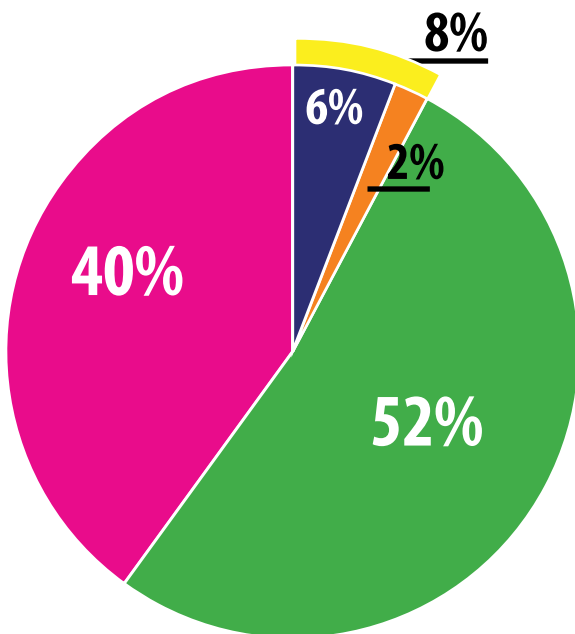
Racial Breakdown of the County

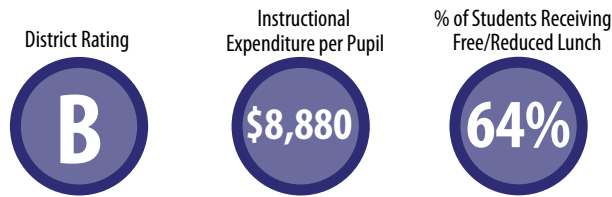
