

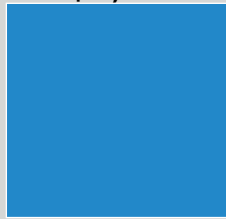

County per Capita Income

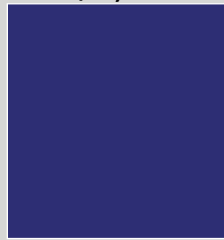

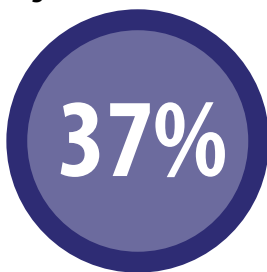

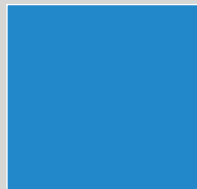

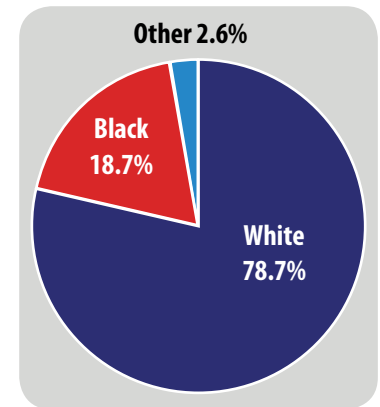

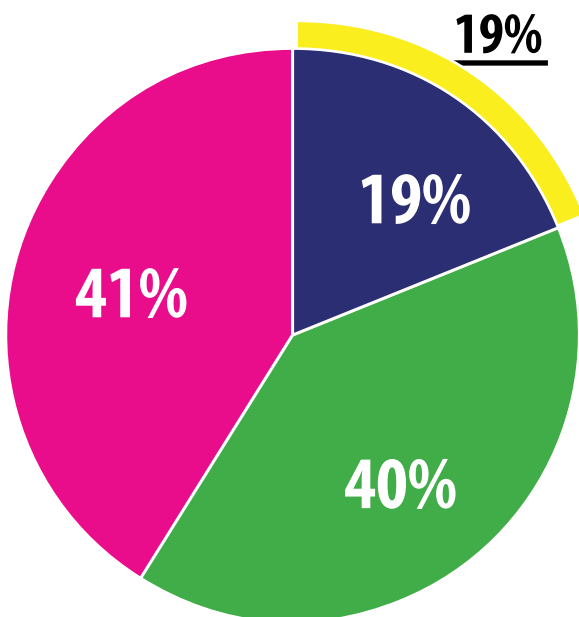

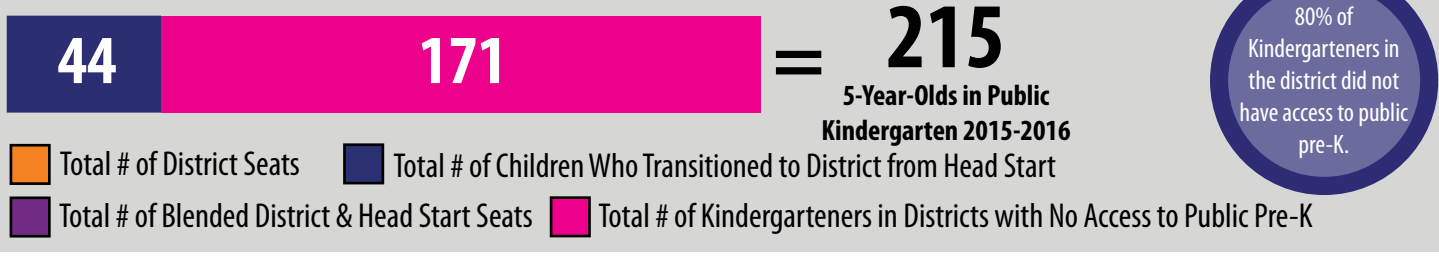
Instructional Expenditure per Pupil
